ACCOMMODATION

1. YMCA Recreation Camp Accommodation

General Information

Comfortable, heated accommodation for approximately 100 people is available in four accommodation blocks.

All accommodation is fully catered and includes 2 breakfasts, 2 cut lunches, the Event Dinner on Saturday evening, plus morning snacks and afternoon teas on Saturday and Sunday. Special dietary needs can be catered for (refer Registration Form).

A range of accommodation options is available, namely two person, three person, four person and six person rooms with a mixture of ensuite, shared ensuite and communal amenities. All beds are bunk style single beds, fitted with comfortable inner spring mattresses and each room has shelves for storage.

Dinner can also be provided on Friday evening for an additional cost of \$10.50 pp. Reservation and payment for this meal are to be included with your Accommodation Booking. (This option is only available to on-site guests.)

Accommodation arrangements and cost

Accommodation charges for the various options are provided in the *Federation 2010 Fee Schedule for YMCA Accommodation* document.

Applicants from Clubs will be expected to book accommodation by the room – ie to arrange groups of 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6. Such bookings will be final and no other person will be allocated to that room. However, if a complete room group cannot be achieved, in consultation with the Club concerned, an attempt will be made to fulfil the booking by combining with others or offering an alternative category of accommodation.

In order that everyone has a fair go, a reasonable maximum for on-site accommodation for any one club will apply.

Limited places will be available for bookings from individual non club-affiliated BWV members, however, this will be dependent on the availability of other such bookings to make up the requested room occupancy.

Rooms will be allocated on a first-come-first-served-basis. Clubs will be advised promptly regarding the outcome of their booking.

All clubs will be notified via email immediately various accommodation options are fully subscribed.

Guests are **required to bring** bedding, including a pillow, a fitted or under sheet, a sleeping bag or doona and a towel.

Duties: Occupants will be allocated limited duties, such as cleaning.
